 - A. The opportunity
 - i. Went
 - ii. Cities & villages
 - iii. synagogues
 - B. The activities
 - i. Teaching
 - ii. Preaching
 - iii. Healing
 - 1. Disciples Attend first way you show teachability
 - Be around
 - Be where ministry is happening
 - Be available
 - Acts 2 they were together

APP: are you creating opportunities and engaging in His activities?

Matt 28:19-20 (no healing) Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you.

II. His Motivation – v. 36

- A. Presenting problems
 - i. harassed
 - ii. helpless
 - iii. leaderless
- B. Personal perspective
 - i. He noticed the crowd
 - ii. He cared about condition (14:13-14; 15:29-32)
 - iii. He knew actual needs

APP: do you have compassion?

Col 3:12; Put on then, as God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, compassionate hearts, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience

If you struggle with compassion - study who you were without Christ

Realize who you are/were: Ezek 18:1-4;

2 Ki 21:15; And I will forsake the remnant of my heritage and give them into the hand of their enemies, and they shall become a prey and a spoil to all their enemies, 15 because they have done what is evil in my sight and have provoked me to anger, since the day their fathers came out of Egypt, even to this day."

Rom 2:1-11

Engage people – 2 Co 5:20-21 therefore we are ambassadors for Christ...

Gal 6:1 Brothers,[a] if anyone is caught in any transgression, you who are spiritual should restore him in a spirit of gentleness. Keep watch on yourself, lest you too be tempted.

2. Disciples observe (1. Attend)

- Notice the need
- Watch what the discipler does and listen to explanation
- Become concerned for the lost

III. His Method – v. 37-38

- A. Speak to others
 - i. Engage disciples
 - ii. Cast vision
 - iii. Call for action
- B. Pray for workers
 - i. God knows the need
 - ii. God moves the individual

iii. God reaps His harvest
