Reward of the Disciple

- 1. Reception, heavenly reward, apostles, salvation (receive father)
- 2. Righteous' Reward earthly reward, prophet/righteous sanctification
- 3. Servant's reward Fatherly reward, disciples service 3 Jn 8

The disciple is rewarded by seeing others become disciples. Others are rewarded for receiving (taking on board) the righteous' instruction. Anyone who cares in the slightest for a disciple is rewarded

But rejectors will be judged. So reception is the key – people need to receive the truth, then their reception and their service is rewarded.

Intro: going after a reward; competing to win; trouble of modern culture – loss of reward
